Highlights of actions and decisions made by the Board this 2010-2011 year.

Buzz Bowl

- The X-Ray Challenge Committee has completed updates to the electronic file. Corrections and clarifications were made to questions debated during last year's program.
- No one liked the name change from the Buzz Bowl to the X-Ray Challenge and so the name was changed back to the Buzz Bowl Competition.

Scholarships

- All MSRT Awarded 5 Scholarships (Flo Wakefield, Oliver E. Merrill, and 3 Quarter Century Club-James Lampka, Lind LaFave, Michael DelVecchio.
- The criteria for all MSRT scholarships were re-evaluated to assure the process was fair and equitable.

- Board approves suggestion by Conference Committee to seek input from students / programs for a potential Conference 2012 theme. If their school's idea is selected, they get a class pizza party.

RT in DC.

- MSRT was represented at RT in DC 2011-March 13-15, 2011 by Dave LeClair, and Lisa Fanning.
- Despite strong support by MSRT, ACR and the MSRPE and other state and national organizations the Care Bill still remains unpassed.
- 2 MSRT representatives attended the 2010 ASRT House of Delegates Meeting. It was in Albuquerque, NM.

New Member Enrollment/ Membership Drive

- We have placed a Membership Drive letter on our Website. It is now online, it goes out with renewals, and will be placed *in The Exposure* and mailed to facilities.

- In an effort to increase new member enrollment and retention the Board has started providing prizes to be raffled away during the renewal drive for existing members who recruit a new member. Julie Henry donated the \$500.

Annual Meeting

- The Board decided NOT to raise registration costs for this annual conference.
