

The revised Radiologic Technologist Licensing Regulations 105 CMR 125.000 have been published. (Effective date February 24, 2017). Massachusetts will now recognize advanced practice certification and require licensing for Computed Tomography (CT), Positron Emission Tomography (PET), Nuclear Medicine Advanced Associate (NMAA) and Radiologist Assistant (RA), including Radiology Practitioner Assistant (RPA). Continuing Education (CE) requirements have also been revised and now require 24 credits to include radiation safety and education directly related to the license(s) you hold. The licensing term and CE biennium will now begin on the first day of your birth month and when renewing your license you will be required to submit proof of current ARRT or NMTCB certification and CE compliance. We know that many of you have questions and we are here to help. The full text of the updated regulations is now available online at member mert-ma org/advocacy/. We have also posted a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document and a summary of the revised Continuing Education (CE) requirements. The information posted has been compiled after careful review and discussion of the regulations. The is always available to answer your questions and will make every effort to assist you in any way we can as the updated regulations are implemented.
