Flexible Online Program through “Control the Dose” Limited X-Ray Program

- All associated program costs are paid for by ConvenientMD
- Duration of program is 6 months

Clinical Apprenticeship hours completed at ConvenientMD Urgent Care Clinics

- 6 month total training time including online coursework
- All training shifts will be scheduled with an RT (R), preceptor

1:1 Mentorship provided by ConvenientMD team member throughout the program

- Regular check-in's provided
- Program progress monitoring and guidance provided
- Monthly skill days to reinforce skills and training
- Set benchmarks to keep students on track

Eligible for LXMO license upon program completion

- State board examination required after program completion
- ConvenientMD requires all State licensure requirements to be completed prior to independent practice

Upon program completion and successful completion of licensure requirements, students will be eligible for a position as a Limited X-Ray Machine Operator at ConvenientMD

- Position availability dependent on current clinical openings
- Team members should be open to available positions in surrounding clinics until a position in their preferred clinic may become available

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will I get compensated for my training shift?

A: Yes, all students will receive their regular hourly rate during training.

Q: Is there a contract required to begin the LXMO program?

A: Yes, CMD requires a 1 year agreement with added retention bonus at 1yr and 2yr post licensure.

Q: What positions can currently apply for the LXMO program?

A: Medical Assistants, Patient Care Techs, Clinical Care Techs, Licensed Practical Nurses, Urgent Care Techs, and Registered Nurses.

Q: How long is the program?

A: The program is designed to be completed within 6 months, which includes all clinical and course work.

Q: Can my clinical requirement be completed during my regular shifts?

A: Clinical training requirements will be completed in tandem with your LXMO apprenticeship.
